How does microchipping work?

A pet microchip is not a GPS Tracking Device. A pet microchip uses a radio frequency known as RFID to transmit an ID number stored on a microchip to the scanning device that reads the pet's unique number and displays it. This ID must be registered to you in our database so you can be reached immediately when your
